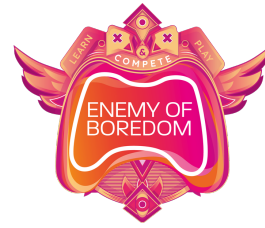

You will be offering students opportunities to enable them to have maximum capabilities and confidence through learning video game design - education without boundaries.

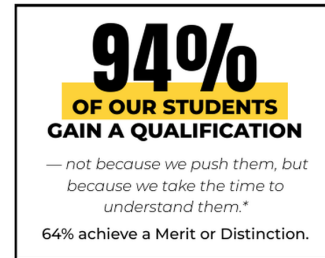
